TECHNIQUE ADVANTAGES

The Differential Straight-Arch® Technique is a comprehensive, fixed orthodontic appliance that facilitates learning because it is divided into three stages of treatment. The bracket has the following advantages:

- It reduces the need for functional appliances, head gear, or any distalizing mechanics.
- Extraction cases can be treated much easier.
- Teeth can be moved using light forces without anchorage strain.
- It reduces the need for orthognathic surgery.
- Anterior deep bites can be opened without the need for bite planes.

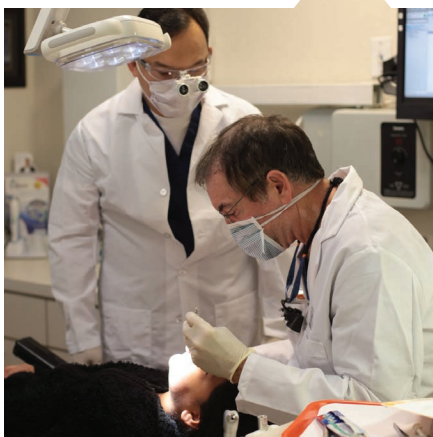
COURSE ADVANTAGES

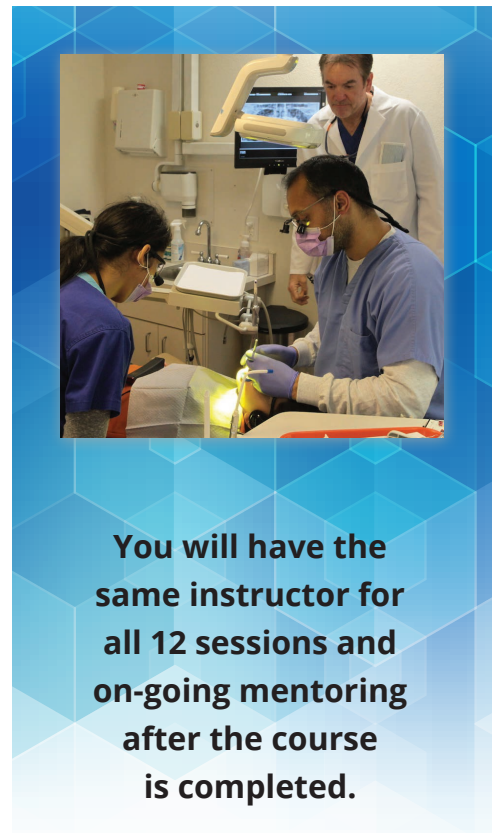


COURSE FORMAT

This Comprehensive Clinical Orthodontic Course will meet one weekend every two months for a total of 12 sessions. **In addition to treating patients, participants will develop a digital library by taking intra-oral photographs of hands-on patients and will give case presentations to the class during the Friday seminar session. 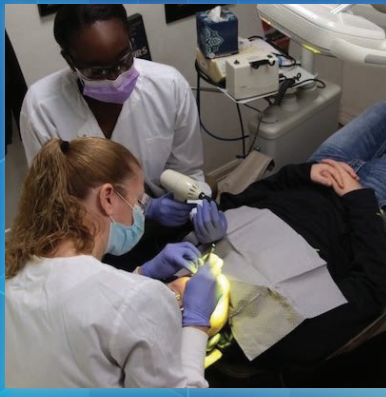

These introductory sessions will assist the participant in making an informed decision as to whether he/she will make the commitment to participate in the comprehensive 12-session hands-on program. This will also allow the instructor, the clinical instructor(s) and/or host dentist the opportunity to meet and interview potential course participants. Course enrollment is based on “a first-come, first-served basis”. Potential enrollees have one week following the introductory session to enroll in the course. 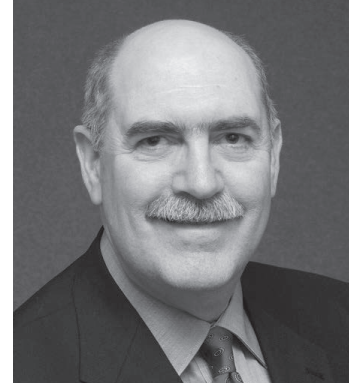

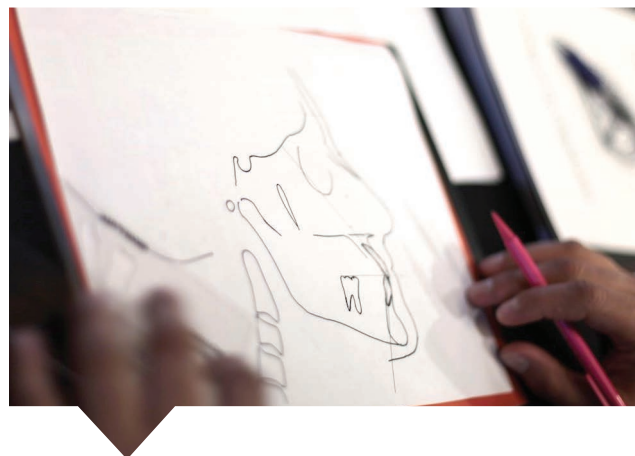

FEES AND CDE HOURS

Tuition for the 12-session course (minimum of 150 CDE hours) is \$14,990 USD, including two years of Academy membership. 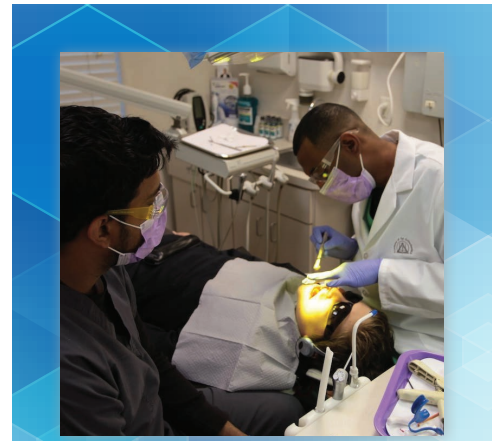
MEMBERSHIP

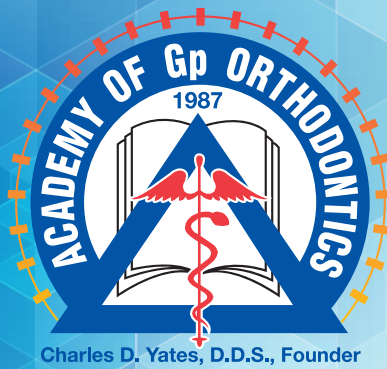
